The Cross Country Vehicle Club (CCVC) runs many trips and events, most of which take place on land owned or managed by organisations or individuals.



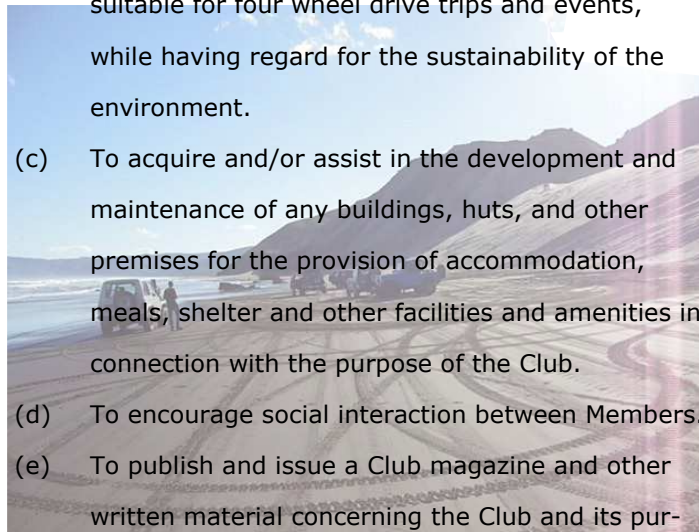
Purpose of Club



The purpose of the Club is (as per Constitution):

- (a) To promote, encourage and conduct four wheel drive trips and events and to assist in the general education and preparation of Members towards safe participation in these activities.
- (b) To support the retention, development, maintenance and utilisation of roads, tracks and places suitable for four wheel drive trips and events, while having regard for the sustainability of the environment.
- (c) To acquire and/or assist in the development and maintenance of any buildings, huts, and other premises for the provision of accommodation, meals, shelter and other facilities and amenities in connection with the purpose of the Club.
- (d) To encourage social interaction between Members.
- (e) To publish and issue a Club magazine and other written material concerning the Club and its purpose.
- (f) To act in co-operation with any Government Department, Local Authority, club, committee, organisation or person for the promotion of the purpose of the Club.

To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the purpose of the Club.
